### Who We Are- Ist Grade

### **Central Idea: Geography influences our community**



#### **Lines of Inquiry:**

- -Earth has many features
- -Circumstances determine where people live
- -Humans investigate the unknown in various ways

#### **Teacher goals for students' learning:**

- -As students learn about landforms, they will make the connection that people can live in/on certain landforms. Students will make the connection that the landform is the basis for how people make a living, find food, and build homes/communities.
- -Students will learn about Lewis and Clark and their exploration of unknown land

#### How can you help at home?

- -Talk with your child about landforms they might have experienced (Kennesaw Mountain, Stone Mountain, Chattahoochee River, Beaches, Lakes, Etowah Mounds, etc.)
- Find pictures of landforms and discuss how people might live on these landforms (i.e. How would a person live on a mountain? How would a person live near a river?)
- -Encourage your child to write about what they have learned about Lewis and Clark- what would you take on an expedition?

#### **Learner Profile Connection**

This unit we will focus on being a **reflective**, **open-minded**, and **knowledgeable**.

# Encourage them at home to be **reflective** by:

- -Discussing how their ideas of exploration has changed over the course of the unit.
- Discuss which IB learner profile your child utilized the most during the new unit?
- -Encourage your child to think about what they have learned so far this year—how are these units connected? What have you learned about the world around you?

## Encourage them at home to be **open-minded** by:

- -Discussing how the exploration of new land might change your perspective
- -Discuss how people would work together, trust others, and/or take someone else's advice
- -Ask your child to think of ways they can listen and learn from others. Being open minded embodies the ability to do this!

### Encourage them at home to be **knowledgeable** by:

- -Discussing landforms with you and where they are located (I.e. Valleys are located in between mountains)
- -Discussing Lewis, Clark, and Sacagawea
- Describe the Corps of Discovery and the difficulties of the journey they experienced.
